

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-3

BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, NEW JERSEY

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, DESIGNATING CERTAIN "STOP" INTERSECTIONS AND DIRECTING THE ERECTION OF STOP SIGNS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Audubon Park adopted Ordinance No. 23 on June 2, 1975 designating certain intersections as “stop” intersections and authorizing the erection of Stop Signs at such intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park have deemed it in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to amend, revise, and supplement Ordinance No. 23.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. Pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, the intersections herein described are designated as stop intersections. Stop signs shall be installed as follows:

<u>Intersection</u>	<u>Stop Signs Shall Be Installed On</u>
Road “B” and Road “C”	Road “C”
Road “A” and Road “B”	Road “B”
Road “A” and Road “C”	Road “C”
Road “C” and Kennedy Drive	Kennedy Drive
Road “C” and Road “D”	Road “D”
Kennedy Drive curve	Stop sign shall be installed at curve.

SECTION II. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION III. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent

jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.
