BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, NEW JERSEY

**ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF AUDUBON PARK, COUNTY OF CAMDEN, AND
STATE OF NEW JERSEY, REGULATING THE MOVEMENT OF VEHICLES IN THE
AUDUBON PARK GRADE SCHOOL PARKING LOT**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park have determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to (1) establish a five (5) mile per hour speed limit in the parking lot of the Audubon Park Grade School and (2) install a stop sign in the parking lot for vehicles exiting on to Kennedy Drive a/k/a “Service Road.”

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Audubon Park, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I. In accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 39:4-197 and N.J.S.A. 39:4-8, the movement of vehicles in the parking lot of the Audubon Park Grade School shall be controlled by, and no person shall operate a vehicle in violation of, the following regulations.

A. Speed Limit. The speed limit in the school parking lot shall be five (5) m.p.h. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the designated speed limit as authorized by the Department of Transportation.

B. Stop Intersection. The exit from the school parking lot on to Kennedy Drive (a/k/a “Service Road”) is hereby designated as a stop intersection, and a stop sign shall be provided therein.

SECTION II. The penalty for a violation and conviction of Section I of this Ordinance shall be not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and/or imprisonment in the County jail for a term not to exceed ninety (90) days, or by a period of community service not to exceed ninety (90) days.

SECTION III. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION IV. If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause

of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, subdivision, or clause of this Ordinance._

SECTION V. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication in accordance with law.

Motion made by Councilwoman Lewis to Introduce Ordinance No. 2008-5. Seconded by Councilman Fisher. Roll call vote: Councilman Fisher-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilwoman Lewis-yes, and Councilman Passon-yes.

Motion made by Councilman Fisher to have the Philadelphia Zoo on Wheel in the Audubon Park Public Library on July 29, 2008 at 12 PM for \$425.00. Seconded by Councilwoman Jones. Roll call vote: Councilman Fisher-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilwoman Lewis-yes, and Councilman Passon-yes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Jones to purchase a computer screen for the Treasurer not to exceed \$300.00. Seconded by Councilman Fisher. Roll call vote: Councilman Fisher-yes, Councilwoman Hook-yes, Councilwoman Jones-yes, Councilwoman Lewis-yes, and Councilman Passon-yes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Lewis to cancel the working session on June 17, 2008. Seconded by Councilwoman Jones. All ayes.

Motion made by Councilwoman Jones to adjourn the meeting at 8:08 PM. Seconded by Councilwoman Lewis.
